Skin care instructions after the procedure Body Tattoo removal RECOMMENDATIONS AFTER THE PROCEDURE:

There are important and crucial steps in the entire removal process to be considered, suchi as the skin restoration after removal procedure using MM Tattoo remover. Within 10-18 days, after the procedure the crusts remain on the skin, it is recommended you keep this clean and avoid creams, powders, ointments, gels. Do not touch the treated area as this will lead to the formation of a scar and prolong the period of healing

* If it becomes wet due to the action of leukocytes or due to accidental contact with water, gently blot the skin with a cotton swab dipped in chlorhexidine to remove moisture.

* After 3 days, you can take a short shower. Contact the treated skin area with water for a short time (no more than 2 minutes) but do not place the treated areas directly under the stream of the shower. Do not scrub with a washcloth or any contact with soap. Ensure you keep the treated area dry, while it heals and use a cotton sponge or a clean and dry towel to gently blot the water, then just let the skin dry. A dark crust on treated area of the skin, which naturally disappears in 10-18 days.

The crust may crack at the edges during the healing process or due to stretching of the skin with movement. When the edges of the crust are flaking, but the rest is still in place. Use a loose, dry, breathable bandage (made of gauze or bandage). Wear clothing that will not chafe until the crust comes off.

* Immediately after the crusts disappear, it is necessary to actively restore the skin with the help of regenerating and healing creams for two weeks. You need to apply the cream twice a day with Bepanthen Plus, Solcoseryl or Dexpanthenol to reduce skin redness and facilitate the process. After that, you need to use Contractubex or Enamel for a further 2 weeks to prevent scars.

* Within two weeks after the crust has disappeared, the skin should be protected from direct sunlight and tanning beds, or use sunscreen with a maximum protection factor. Otherwise, due to a violation of the integrity of the skin, and not due to the effect of the product, pigmentation may occur on the skin.

* In case of infection, use cotton pads soaked in 2% hydrogen peroxide solution (available from pharmacies), gently press the pad against the skin surface to sterilize, then apply an antibiotic ointment to the skin along the edges of the crust. If the infection continues to progress,

antibiotics such as penicillin should be taken (consult and get a prescription from your doctor). * If itching occurs while the treated area is healing, do not itch your skin. You can use a patting motion to relieve itching and apply an anti-itch / soothing ointment (available at the pharmacy). Excessive scratching of the treated area during the healing period can cause scars.

A second procedure to remove pigment in the same area of the skin can be performed after the skin has completely healed (usually 1.5-2.5 months).
